

## Privacy Statement SkyNRG B.V.

SkyNRG B.V. ("SkyNRG"), situated in Amsterdam, the Netherlands, is the global market leader for sustainable aviation fuel (SAF) solutions, having supplied over 25 airlines on all continents. SkyNRG sources, blends and distributes SAF, guarantees sustainability throughout the supply chain and helps to co-fund the premium. At the same time, SkyNRG focuses on developing regional supply chains that offer a real sustainable and affordable alternative to fossil fuels.

SkyNRG deems careful handling of personal data to be paramount. Personal data is carefully processed and secured. When processing, we adhere to the requirements of the General Data Protection Regulation (the "Rules"). This Privacy Statement relates to personal information collected by, or under the control of SkyNRG, in accordance with the Rules.

In this Privacy Statement, we summarise what personal data we collect and use and for what purpose. We advise you to read our Privacy Statement carefully. This Privacy Statement applies to our website <http://skynrg.com/> related sites and communications.

### Use of personal data

By visiting our website or registering for our newsletters, you may share your personal data with us.

### Types of Data Collected

We may collect the following information about you:

- Personal identification data: name, surname;
- Contact information data: email;
- Other provided data: IP address.

### Purposes of processing

Personal data is generally processed by SkyNRG for the following purposes:

- Sending and delivering newsletters;
- Communication between SkyNRG and website visitors;
- Analysing statistics and optimising the website functionality.

We collect your personal data based on legitimate business interests (website) or consent (newsletters). If the processing is based on consent, it can be withdrawn at any time.

## **Data Storage**

In principle, we only keep your data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes described in this Privacy Statement, for which your data have been collected. As a general rule, we store the data our website visitors for 14 months. The data of persons using our newsletter services are stored until they opt-out of these services.

## **Your rights**

You have the right to request access to the information we have about you. You can do this by contacting us directly. We will make sure to provide you with a copy of the data we process about you in a machine-readable format. We may need to verify your identity to comply with your request.

If you believe that the information we have about you is incorrect, you can contact us so we can update the information to ensure it is accurate. You also have the right to object to certain data processing operations. If at any point you wish for us to delete information about you, you can communicate it to us.

You can contact us at any time with these requests and we will respond in a timely manner applicable with the Rules. If you are unsatisfied with the reply received from us, you may then refer your complaint to the relevant supervisory authority.

## **Provision to third parties**

We will not share the data you have provided us, other than in accordance with this statement, with other parties if you have not given us permission to do so, unless this is required by the law.

## **Cookies and Analytics**

On our website, we make use of functional cookies. Additionally, when you use our service, your IP address is automatically saved in the log files of our web server. This is necessary to allow us to properly manage, optimize, and secure our services. You can always refuse those cookies.

On our website we use a tracking cookie. This cookie is placed in the browser. We do not store any personal information without your consent, but track what you find interesting. This way we can provide you with relevant information. You can always refuse the cookie.

Data of website visitors may be kept for making statistical analyses including via Google Analytics. These statistics are used to optimise our services. Wherever possible, we pseudonymize this data.

### **Security**

We take security measures in order to limit misuse of and unauthorised access to personal data. In particular, we take the following measures:

- Encryption of data;
- Pseudonymising data;
- Purpose-bound access limitations;
- Control of acknowledged authorisations.
